

Campbell Road, Salisbury

A classic red-brick period house, believed to be built around the turn of the 20th century, with scope to improve and delightful views of the historic cathedral.









Description

The accommodation is arranged over three floors, extending to 1,118 sq ft of living space, including a bay-fronted sitting room with a period fireplace, a dining room with a well-equipped kitchen beyond. There are three perfectly proportioned bedrooms and modern family bathroom on the first floor. The principal bedroom with an en suite shower room occupies the entire second floor. Externally there is a good size rear garden, mostly laid to lawn.


Situation






